Who is eligible for coverage?



All regular, full-time Eligible Participants and Eligible Dependents of the educational organization or institution who: 1. Are engaged in international educational activities; 2. Are temporarily located outside this/her home country as a non-resident alien; 3. Have not obtained permanent residency status.

HTH benefits

In addition to providing comprehensive sickness and accident insurance, the HTH Worldwide policy provides emergency travel medical insurance, including coverage for medical evacuation and repatriation of remains, which generally is not provided by domestic insurance policies. HTH also has identified a network of doctors worldwide who will provide treatment and file claims on your behalf without requiring payment at the time of treatment. Prior to departure for study abroad, HTH assists students in establishing treatment for ongoing medical conditions while abroad (including doctor visits and continuing medications). The Medex Secure Rider for study abroad students includes political evacuation services, security evacuation services, transportation after security or political evacuation, and real-time security intelligence.
